

Midwifery Assistants

Here at the Bend Birth Center, we believe in offering clinical opportunities for midwifery students to study and practice clinical skills. Within our midwifery practice, we may have one or two students apprenticing with us at a time. These students will be in prenatal and postpartum visits and will assist us at your birth. We believe that the time they spend with us is both valuable for their education and experience, but also that this time benefits you; giving you a chance to get to know them before your birth.

In addition we also utilize other licensed midwives and registered nurses to help at your labor and delivery. We will introduce all birth assistants at your 37 week visit. So they have the time to hear your birth preferences and give you an opportunity to ask any questions you may have.
